

2002 Shiraz

Adelaide Hills South Australia

This premium Shiraz wine was made from grapes hand picked in small parcels to fully maximize fruit quality and flavour intensity. 2002 harvest saw the lowest yields ever experienced by Paul and Kathy Drogemuller in their Paracombe vineyard.

The grapes underwent slow, cool ferments in open tanks, hand plunged and then gently pressed to gain a soft extraction of flavour and tannins. The wine was then left to gracefully mature for twenty months in French Oak barriques.

Paracombe Shiraz will delight with rich aromas, concentrated flavours, and cool climate elegance. This vintage's dark ruby colour accompanies an intense bouquet of cherries, plums, pepper and spice.

The palate is well balanced, delivering layered flavours of rich, spicy fruit, hints of dark chocolate and subtle oak.

A complete wine to enjoy for many years with cellaring - that is, if you can keep your hands off it!
